

JSRC Triple Crown Series

Participation Guidelines and Scoring Procedure

Purpose:

The JSRC Triple Crown series was created to encourage friendly, head-to-head competition between JSRC members and help increase member participation in the club's fall road races. Since we hold these races primarily for you - our club members, we want you to enter and enjoy these races.

The JSRC Triple Crown Series consists of 3 races:

- Deal Five Mile - Sunday October 14
- Trick Or Trot 4 Mile - Sunday October 28
- Navesink Challenge 15K - Sunday November 25

To participate and to be scored and ranked in the series, you must:

- Be a current member of JSRC (dues paid as of 10/1/07)
- Be a registered finisher in at least 2 of the 3 races in the JSRC Triple Crown series
- Turn in your place card for scoring at each race with **JSRC marked on your card**

Scoring System:

- There will be 10 year age groups for both men and women to start the series: 19 and under; 20-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59; 60-69; 70-79; 80 and up.
- If we have enough participation in any age group, we reserve the right to divide that AG into two 5 year AG's.
- Based on the final results of each race, JSRC members who officially finish any of these races will receive points on the following system within each age group:

1st – 10 points

2nd – 8 points

3rd – 6 points

4th – 4 points

5th – 2 points

6th – 1 point

- Those participants who finished and were recorded for at least 2 of the races will qualify for series awards. Total points at the end of the series will determine the series winners in each age group.

Awards:

- The series winner of each age group will receive a special JSRC item.
- Anyone who places first in their age group in all 3 of the races will receive an additional award.
- All decisions of the JSRC Triple Crown committee are final.
